

3rd Round of funding: DEFRA support to people in poverty

Bids are invited for the 3rd round of DEFRA funding, via Northants County Council, and administered by Hope, to support activity to help people on low incomes.

The money can only be spent on direct, demonstrable costs in supplying food and other essential items to people in proven need. Bidders must be able to show they can reach people in need and have systems in place to ensure fair distribution of food and other support. The fund cannot be used for salaries or capital items or renovation; nor for historic expenditure: it must be for new, direct spend such as purchase of food and toiletries, volunteer or staff expenses. If in doubt about whether your idea will meet the criteria, ring us for advice on 01604214300.

Maximum bid size is £75k for partnerships, £25k for a single agency or organisation, but the vast majority of awards will be for much less than these figures; there is a limited fund size remaining so please be reasonable and realistic. If submitting a partnership bid it must be a real, active partnership

All activity must occur before 31/3 and happen in the West Northants Unitary area.
